- Dr. Asheesh Bedi is a Harold and Helen W. Gehring Early Career Professor of Orthopaedic Surgery and Professor of Sports Medicine and Shoulder Surgery at the University of Michigan and MedSport Program.
- Dr. Bedi's research has focused on shoulder, elbow, knee and hip injuries in athletes. He has authored over one hundred articles, chapters and peer-reviewed publications on these topics.
- Dr. Bedi is a team physician for the University of Michigan and Eastern Michigan University and a consultant for the NFL and NHL Players Association.
- In 2010, he was the winner of the Neer Award of the American Shoulder and Elbow Surgeons and a recipient of the Cabaud Award from the American Orthopaedic Society for Sports Medicine.
